



## **MANUFACTURER COMMERCIAL WARRANTY CONTRACT – EXTENDED WARRANTY**

(January 2026 Edition)

PEUGEOT MOTOCYCLES grants the customer a manufacturer's commercial warranty covering the vehicles and components expressly listed in Articles 1.1 and 1.2 against defects in materials or workmanship.

The manufacturer provides a two-year warranty on its products. In addition, for the products listed in Articles 1.1 and 1.2, PEUGEOT MOTOCYCLES grants this additional commercial warranty for a maximum total period of forty-eight (48) months from the date of first registration, subject to the conditions set out herein ("Extended Commercial Warranty").

### **1. WHAT DOES THE COMMERCIAL WARRANTY COVER?**

#### **1.1 Eligible products**

- Peugeot Motorcycles, Django by Peugeot and KISBEE by Peugeot brands only.
- Scooters and motorcycles of 125cc and above.
- Euro 5 or Euro 5+ compliant.
- Excluding electric vehicles.
- Purchased and first registered through an authorised PEUGEOT MOTOCYCLES dealer from 1 January 2026.

#### **1.2 Covered components**

- Frame, swing arm, engine mount.
- Internal engine moving parts (connecting rods, cylinder/liner, timing gear, oil pump, cylinder heads and head gaskets, gearbox).
- Fuel system: fuel pump, injector.
- Stator and regulator.
- Braking system.
- Fuel tank.
- Cooling system: water pump, radiator, fan.
- ECUs/control units.

- Instrument panel.
- Handlebar controls, switches and contactors.
- Wheels/rims (excluding bearings and spokes).

Covered services:

- Repair or replacement of parts recognised as defective by PEUGEOT MOTOCYCLES.
- Labour directly related to covered repairs.

### 1.3 Exclusions

The extended warranty does not cover routine maintenance, clutch assemblies, exhaust systems, spark plugs, filters, belts, hoses, cables, brake wear items, wheel bearings, tyres, suspension wear items, stands, footrests, batteries, bulbs, locks, bodywork, seats, trim, consumables, fuel, lubricants, accessories, or any normal wear-and-tear items.

The warranty also excludes damage caused by accidents, theft, vandalism, fire, misuse, racing, competition use, modifications, poor maintenance, improper storage, unsuitable fuels or lubricants, continued use after a fault, consequential losses, intentional damage, or defects existing before the warranty became effective.

## 2. DURATION OF THE EXTENDED WARRANTY

### 2.1 Duration

Coverage may continue up to forty-eight (48) months from the date of first registration. Repairs or replacements do not extend the warranty period.

### 2.2 Limitations

- Vehicle older than four (4) years or exceeding 60,000 km.
- No coverage for vehicles purchased for professional/commercial use.

### 2.3 Transferability

The extended warranty remains valid for subsequent owners provided all duration and limitation conditions remain satisfied. The new owner must provide details to an authorised PEUGEOT MOTOCYCLES dealer within 30 days of purchase.

## 3. HOW TO CLAIM THE EXTENDED WARRANTY

- The customer must activate the extended warranty through the dedicated PEUGEOT MOTOCYCLES website within two months of sale.
- All maintenance and repairs relating to covered components must comply with PEUGEOT MOTOCYCLES requirements.
- Maintenance must be recorded in the PEUGEOT MOTOCYCLES digital service record.
- Original proof of purchase must be presented.
- Maintenance schedules and tolerances specified by the manufacturer must be respected.

- Maintenance and repair records must be retained and supplied on request.
- All applicable recall campaigns must have been completed.
- Genuine approved parts must be used.

#### 4. TERRITORIAL APPLICATION

The warranty applies within the European Economic Area, including Switzerland and the United Kingdom, subject to local operating recommendations and applicable legislation.

#### 5. COMMERCIAL WARRANTY – ECONOMIC TOTAL LOSS

PEUGEOT MOTOCYCLES may refuse a repair where the total repair cost exceeds the fair market value of the vehicle. In such cases it may offer either:

- (i) a replacement solution of equivalent value, or
- (ii) reimbursement of the fair market value of the vehicle.

#### 6. LEGAL RIGHTS

This commercial warranty is additional to and does not affect statutory consumer rights, including:

- The legal guarantee of conformity.
- Protection against hidden defects.

Consumers retain all rights provided under applicable national laws.
